Expectations of a Peer Advocate (PAWS) Member:

- Attend all training sessions and monthly meetings
- Voting on group business as relevant at monthly meetings/trainings (i.e. quorum)
- Actively assisting with Career Services events and programs
- Help create and submit marketing materials and social media updates for events
- Develop and present one (1) group program or project per semester
- Conduct at least one (1) career-related presentation for a residence hall, student organization, classroom, or other outreach efforts per semester.
- Maintenance of a 2.25 minimum GPA
- Provide Peer Counseling to students as needed
